**Guest Speaker: Paul Finch OBE**

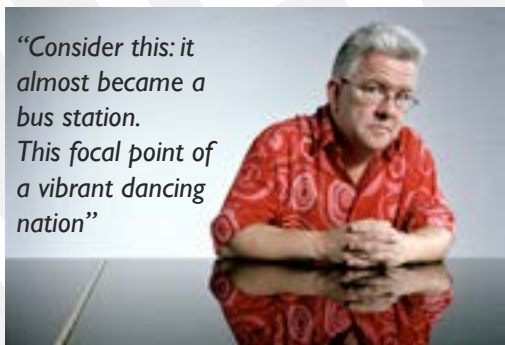
